**Country** – a large area of land where people live under the same government or have the same culture.

**Region** - an area of the earth's surface that has certain features of land and climate.

**Europe** – a continent that is between Asia and the Atlantic ocean and is north of the Mediterranean sea.

**Location** – place or position

**Landscape** – the area that can be seen from one point.

**Weather** – the conditions outside at a particular place and time.

**Climate** – the long term weather patterns of an area.

**Tourism** – the act of travelling, usually for sightseeing or relaxing.


**Germany** – a country in central, northern Europe.

**Human Geography** - focuses on where people live, what they do and how they use the land.


**Physical Geography** – is the study of processes that shape the earth's surface.


